KNOW ACCOUNTING AND FINANCE

Accounting focuses on the management of financial reports and records such as book-keeping, managing balance sheets and income statements. These types of data are used to plan company finances to achieve business goals. There are 3 key areas in accounting, which are financial, cost accounting and management accounting.

- Financial accounting is used to keep track of a company's financial transactions while following standardised guidelines to record and summarise financial data in a report.
- Cost accounting collects financial information about a company's overall costs and evaluates the efficiency of its usage. From this, the administration can make informed decisions about the production capacity and other resources of the business.
- Management accounting plays a role in facilitating the management in making informed decisions regarding the economic resources, performance, and rate of return of the capital.

Finance deals with the management of money for businesses and organisations in terms of planning, organising and controlling finances. It involves a wide range of finance activities including investment, financial planning and commercial banking.

- Personal finance is the process of planning and managing one's finances by saving and investing via a budget and comprehensive strategy.
- Corporate finance involves dealing with the capital of a corporation to increase the value of a company through capital investments, capital financing and return of capital.
- Public finance, also known as government finance, is responsible for assessing government revenue and expenditure to achieve economic growth.

Careers in mergers and acquisations are diverse. This is big business and is how some medium to large firms seek expansion. Investment banks support clients by helping finance these activities.


Insurance

OTHER CAREER

Accountants

An accountant is responsible for preparing and maintaining financial statements by strictly adhering to accounting principles and standards. They also advise on revenue and expenditure of business transactions.

Auditors

An auditor is responsible for checking the accuracy of business and financial records to ensure they comply with laws and regulations. They work to prepare reports and act as consultants to advise on the efficiency of a client's accounting processes as well as risk management.

Financial Analysts

They determine the cost of operations by collecting, monitoring and analysing data to recommend the next best course of action. They oversee the entire process from identifying the financial status of a business or an organisation, compare the results with forecasts and recommend solutions to the management.

Chartered Accountants

Requires certification from a professional accounting body to be able to audit account statements. This could involve forensic accounting, corporate finance, business recovery and insolvency.

Financial Advisor

Advises clients on financial decisions and strategies on investment planning, insurance coverage, cash management as well as helping them to set and realise their personal finance goals.
